### Re-engage Wyndham Program

### at Wyndham CEC

Wyndham CEC is part of an exciting initiative in Wyndham aimed at providing an integrated education program for young people at risk of disengaging from education or who have already disengaged.

### **Course Details**

Wyndham CEC has developed a course designed for the 15-17 year old target group.

The course is delivered in a community setting, full time over 10 weeks in Term 2 or 10 weeks in Term 3.

The course focuses on re-engagement and transitions for 15-17 year olds and offers individualised support for participants who require language, literacy, numeracy and digital literacy skills.

Students successfully completing this course will be awarded the qualification 22280VIC Certificate I in Employment Pathways or a statement of attainment for units completed.

This qualification is recognised nationally.




