This qualification equips you to work with children between 0 and 5 years of age. Workers at this level have responsibility for the supervision of other staff and volunteers. In Victoria this is usually the highest qualification required to work as Director or Service Manager of a centre-based care service.

If you do not have a current Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30113) you will enrol in our 18 month study option. With this option you would study 1 day per week for a total of 60 sessions over 18 months.
