Things to remember

- Students who are not funded can still enrol as a full fee paying student. The fee rates are different (payment plans are available) and students cannot enrol online but must enrol in person at our head office. Contact us on 9742 4013 to discuss further.
- The rules of our funding body state students cannot repeat a class they've successfully completed within the same calendar year. If you want to repeat a class you can enrol as a fee for service student and pay the full fee rate (payment plans are available). Contact us on 9742 4013 to discuss further.
