### Proof of Evidence of Citizenship/Residency and age

You are required to bring the following original documents with you to the Pre-Training Assessment Interview.

- Valid and current Medicare Card
- Australian Birth Certificate or
- Current Passport (either Australian or New Zealand) or
- Formal confirmation of permanent residence granted by the Department of Home Affairs (or its successor) AND the applicant's foreign passport or ImmiCard.
- A valid and current Centrelink Concession Card if applicable (Health Care, Pensioner, etc.)
- School Report/s
- Any Certificates / Statement of Attainment/s
- All applicants who enrol into the program are required to undertake the CSPA (Core Skills Profile for Adults)/LLN (Language, Literacy and Numeracy) Testing. The CSPA/LLN comprises of three parts: Literacy, Numeracy and Writing.
- The CSPA/LLN takes approx. 45 minutes to complete the Pre-Training Assessment Interview will take approx. 30 minutes.

After the PTA, if successful, a Letter of Offer to enrol into either the VPC or VCE VM program will be issued.
